The Execution of Unwanted Family Members

"Mary arose in those days, and went into the hill country ... and saluted Elisabeth. ...when Elisabeth heard the salutation of Mary, THE BABE LEPT IN HER WOMB..." (Luke 1:39-42)

Dr. Luke, the only medical physician called of the Almighty to write Scripture, penned the above verse. (Colossians 4:14) He didn't write this by inspiration of the New England Journal of Medicine. He wrote it by inspiration of God. (2 Timothy 3:16,17) The word "babe" is actually the Greek word "brephos" meaning "an infant (properly unborn), a young child, a breathing, nursing infant." He used this EXACT same word when writing about the baby Jesus once He had exited His Mother's womb. (Luke 2:12) When Almighty God speaks inspirationally through a Physician informing the world that a "fetus" in a womb is "a breathing, nursing infant," how dare the United States Supreme Court declare otherwise? In 1973 the Supreme Court did exactly that by ruling that to terminate a "brepho's" life in the womb is the Constitutional "Right" of the Mother. Since then over 40 million unwanted family members have been executed in their Mothers' wombs, 98% for non-medical reasons. That's 30 million more than Hitler executed during the Holocaust. He made soap and lamp shades out of his Holocaust victims. We make cosmetics and "Miracle" drugs out of our Holocaust victims!

Someone always says, "Fetuses don't breath and nurse in the womb." Yes, they do. Through their own life support system they extract both oxygen and sustenance. That's breathing and eating! A fish draws oxygen from water and that's called breathing. So it's breathing when a "brephos" does it in a water sac in Mom's belly! It's time to just read the Bible, grow up and adjust.

Dr. Luke also wrote that the babe (John the Baptist) "lept" in the

womb. This word actually means, "to skip and jump for JOY." Blobs don't experience joy. Blobs don't experience any emotion. Human beings do. Little John recognized voices from the womb, while his little heart pumped 25 quarts of blood a day. That's human status. Talking about human status, Los Angeles County, California, finds thousands of aborted "brephos" in dumpsters annually. The County BURIES these little children with dignity, giving them human status in death. Yet in Mom's womb, they are denied the same status. The womb has become a tomb.

Millions have asked, "When does life begin in the womb?" Of course, when the sperm and egg come together. It's at that exact same moment that God imparts PHYSICAL LIFE. However, the Bible reveals that God knows each one of us personally, including the plans He has for us BEFORE the womb! (Jeremiah 1:4,5; Psalm 127:34; 139:1-24)

If you're considering an abortion, think on this. One day you yourself are going to die. When you do, you'll not stand before the ACLU, the National Organization of Women (NOW) or the U.S. Supreme Court to give account for taking your child's life and interrupting a work of God in progress. (Ephesians 2:10) You'll stand before the Almighty. (2Corinthians 5:10) The ACLU, NOW and U.S. Supreme Court members will be crouching in the shadows, denying they ever influenced you.

Why not say, "Jesus, You're my choice. If You'll protect me and provide for me, I'll let this "brephos" live and dedicate its life to serving You." (Psalm 103:1-5; Romans 10:13) If you've had an abortion or made it possible for others, why not say, "God forgive me. I didn't know what the Bible said. Thanks for taking the blinders off my eyes, in Jesus' Name." He'll do as you ask. (1John 1:9)

Abortion in America will soon be spoken of with the same shame that we now speak of Slavery. Supporters of owning slaves also argued that it was a matter of "personal choice." Like abortion advocates today, they insisted, "Freedom of choice is what this Country is all about." True, but not freedom to choose to trash the rights of other human beings. It's a hard word I know. But

abortion is nothing more than the execution of unwanted family members 98% of the time.
